To all Equine owners, managers, veterinarians, and other role players,

Applications for the direct movement of horses from Gauteng into the AHS control zones opened on Friday 23 July. **A CONFIRMED AHS CASE** in the Randvaal area has necessitated the re-closure of certain parts of Gauteng Province for direct movement into the AHS control zones. Facilities affected include **Turffontein Racecourse, and the TBA complex**.

The situation will be reviewed on 1 September. Until 1 September DIRECT movement into the AHS control zones will be prohibited from the affected areas. Horses wishing to travel into the control zones from these areas will be required to complete **14 days stopover quarantine**.

Isolated areas in the Northern Cape, Free State, Eastern Cape are still closed for direct movement into the control zones as well as Mpumalanga, and Limpopo.
